- GRAD site
 - o Final stages of compiling application to present to state.
 - Peachtree Business Park
 - o Concept has been delivered.
 - o We've had our initial meeting with DCA, the SGRC, and our engineers to begin pursuing \$500K in One Georgia funding.
 - o Estimated project cost: \$1million to \$1.2million.
 - o Put in new road which will be maintained by city, extend water & sewer lines, put in a pump station.
- Workforce Development/College & career Academy
 - o FHSCCA app that will allow students to access all major employers, will eventually take it to the public.
 - o In collaboration with Wiregrass, a grant has been submitted to the EDA for the development of a CDL training center.
- Lippert
 - o Completing due diligence and should be ready to close soon, they will be adding 25,000 square feet and an axle production line.
- Choice Wood
 - o Informed the potential buyers and Conger that we are not offering incentives for their acquisition.
- Custom Profiles
 - o Sale closed in September, have added 40 new jobs in the past 12+ months with starting pay of \$15/hr. for no experience and \$18/hr. for experience.
 - o New building will create 12 to 15 new jobs.
 - o Looking at 2023 groundbreaking.
- Polar Beverages
 - o Grant award for staging area is hung up at state level.
 - o GEDA awarded the Small Community Deal of the Year "preparation community made to prepare" was the difference maker. There will be an awards luncheon on November 14, 2022 starting at
