  - o Budget 1.62 million, Grant \$500k want to explore and move forward a portion being funded by borrowing \$500k to \$600k.
- 808 E. Oconee Street
  - o Needs concrete repair, priced locally \$36,746. Kathy Young would like to check on price for public works to do concrete work.

- Workforce Development/College & career Academy

  - o City will begin demolition soon.
